



# *Find Books at the Tisch Library and Beyond*

*Tisch Library at Tufts University*

Books offer a variety of information for the international relations researcher. Use the following databases, in the suggested order, to find books at Tufts and at other libraries around the country.

1. The **Tufts Catalog** displays holdings of Tisch, Ginn, and the other Tufts libraries. If you don't know how to search it, see the help pages, visit the Reference Desk at any Tufts library, or make an appointment with a librarian for indepth or ongoing assistance.
2. The **Boston Library Consortium Virtual Catalog** is a collaboration of 19 BLC member libraries and several large public library systems. Search it to identify books that are held at any of the libraries, and request items that are unavailable at any Tufts library. Note that when you use the request feature, you need to allow time for your requests to be processed and sent to Tisch or Ginn for you to borrow.
3. The **Harvard Libraries Catalog** contains over 9 million records for more than 14 million books, manuscripts, government documents, maps, microforms, sound recordings, visual materials, and data files. To request materials at Harvard (or any other library), complete an **Interlibrary Loan form** or apply at the Tisch Reference Desk for a Harvard letter, which allows you a certain number of visits to various Harvard libraries.
4. **WorldCat** is a database of over 50 million holdings of libraries nationwide and in some other countries. It includes a variety of materials, from manuscripts written in the 11th century to websites and DVDs. Use it to look up topics, titles, authors; complete bibliographic citations; borrow materials not owned by Tufts from other libraries; identify holdings of libraries you plan to travel to, etc. Searches can be limited by format, date, language, and availability at Tisch. Results can be printed, emailed and exported to a bibliographic citation manager. For more information, see WorldCat's [help](#) pages.
